Newest member guitarist/vocalist Roger Shephard is no stranger to the music scene. Having performed from Virginia Beach to Cocoa Beach, Roger has hundreds of performances to his credit. Having worked with Atlanta luminaries such as Larry Savage and Barry Richman, Roger brings a harder edge to BluesNV.
