When founding editor, Luana K. Mitten, first began iterating on the idea of launching a small book press, she had already cultivated a deep passion for working with and developing authors. She spent the better part of fifteen years in the publishing industry, working in a variety of editorial roles, including editor-in-chief. But, like many women trying to navigate the delicate balance between motherhood and a fulfilling career, she found the prospect of frequent travel and long hours away from her son difficult. She could not both be the mother she wanted and follow her passion for publishing by working for a traditional publishing house, so Luana harnessed her entrepreneurial spirit—and a good dose of courage—and took a leap of faith, establishing BeaLu Books in July 2015.

"I want readers to find books that engage them, motivate them to read more and see themselves as a reader and writer," says Mitten of the driving motivation behind BeaLu Books. "I want readers to feel like the books were written for them, not at them. I want them to find books that provide support and challenges, broaden their vocabulary, and make them more engaged with the world around them."

Since its inception, the small but mighty children's book press has published more than a dozen titles geared towards K-5 and middle-grade readers. "Every element of our books is intentional to provide the best experience for readers," says Luana, who employs a vibrant mix of talented creatives that help shape her authors' visions for their books, from editorial development to illustration and design. "Each book presents its own set of challenges. Sometimes it's the length of text, sometimes it's balancing writing craft with content, sometimes it's editing to make characters crisp and clear."
